Explore 2025's Darkest Skies with roadsurfer



September 2025: Stargazing is one of the biggest travel trends of the year, with 2025 described as the best year in a decade for spectacular celestial events. From September through to the end of 2025, travellers can expect to see dazzling meteor showers and glowing supermoons in the UK.

October - December: Supermoons (Hunter's Moon, Beaven's Moon, Cold Moon), South Downs

Supermoons occur when a full moon is at the closest point to Earth during its orbit, making it seem much larger and brighter than usual.

21st - 22nd October: Orionid Meteor Shower, Yorkshire Dales

The Orionids, fragments of Halley's Comet, streak across the night sky in October. Usha Gap Campsite near Muker offers wide horizons and dark skies.

17th – 18th November: Leonid Meteor Shower, Galloway Forest Park

Scotland's first Dark Sky Park is an ideal setting for the Leonids. Travellers can stay at Glentrool Camping Site or make the most of permitted wild camping.

13th – 14th December: Geminid Meteor Shower, Brecon Beacons

The Geminids are considered the most spectacular shower of the year. Ynysfaen Camping near Sennybridge provides a prime viewing point in the heart of Brecon Beacons.

What sets roadsurfer apart is its customer-centric approach. Before embarking on their journey in one of the colourful campervans with its unique design wraps, every renter receives a detailed vehicle briefing, complete with instructional videos, 360-degree images, and comprehensive how-to guides.
