For a taste of traditional Cotswold hospitality, continue to [The Porch House](#) in Stow-on-the-Wold, England's oldest inn, for a relaxed pub meal before heading on to the next stop.

Yorkshire – for local produce, artisan makers and hearty food: From the coast to the moors, Yorkshire offers an impressive variety of regional produce, with Malton at the heart of its thriving food scene. Explore [Talbot Yard Food Court](#), a charming converted coaching yard home to six independent producers and food makers, with everything from Yorkshire cheeses and rare-breed meat to seafood, game, fruit and vegetables, alongside locally made beer, cider and wine. Enjoy the freedom to cook with local finds outdoors, or stop at a traditional pub with a Michelin starred restaurant such as [The Black Swan at Oldstead](#) for a taste of Yorkshire before continuing through its countryside and market towns.
