Where to go for scenic walking trails and spring blooms by campervan in the UK & Ireland:

Dove Stone Reservoir & Saddleworth Moor, Peak District

Just outside Manchester, this is an ideal campervan stop with scenic roads and easy access to wide open moorland around Dove Stone Reservoir. Nearby dales like Dovedale and Lathkill Dale offer a natural next stop, with orchids, buttercups and bluebells later in the season.

Best for: big landscapes, flexible stop-offs and quieter spring exploration by van

When to go: April for fresh greenery and cotton grass; May - June for wildflowers in the valleys

Nearest rental locations: Manchester

The Daffodil Way, Gloucestershire

Within easy reach of Bristol, the Cotswolds are perfect for a relaxed campervan route, with plenty of charming places to stop along the way. The Daffodil Way shines in early spring, followed by bluebells and wildflowers across nearby woodlands and trails.

Best for: relaxed touring, village stopovers and vibrant early-season blooms

When to go: April for daffodils; late April - May for bluebells and mixed wildflowers

Nearest rental locations: Bristol

Ashridge Estate, Buckinghamshire

A great short campervan trip from London, Ashridge Estate offers easy parking and access to one of the UK's best bluebell displays. The surrounding Chiltern Hills are ideal for slow, scenic driving between countryside viewpoints and walking trails.

Best for: accessible campervan trips and classic spring woodland scenery

When to go: Mid-April to early May for peak bluebells

Nearest rental locations: London

Glen Finglas, The Trossachs

From Edinburgh, Glen Finglas is a scenic campervan destination with dramatic drives and a more remote feel. Wake up to expansive views before exploring woodlands filled with bluebells and fresh spring growth.

Best for: remote-feeling road trips and immersive Highland landscapes

When to go: Late April - May for bluebells; May - early June for the best overall spring conditions

Nearest rental locations: Edinburgh

Howth Cliff Walk, Dublin

Just outside Dublin, this is an easy campervan stop along the coast with nearby parking and quick access to the trail. The route features colourful wildflowers, sea thrift and sweeping ocean views throughout spring.

Best for: coastal drives, fresh sea air and scenic short walks

When to go: April - June for coastal wildflowers; May for peak colour

Nearest rental locations: Dublin

A season of colour stretching from coast to countryside, spring brings a constantly changing display across the UK and Ireland.
