From heading west to discover the rugged landscapes of Big Bend National Park, Marfa, Alpine and Terlingua, to following Route 66 through North Texas to Amarillo, Lubbock and Palo Duro Canyon, the second-deepest canyon in the U.S. Or alternatively embark on a BBQ-themed journey through the culinary hotspots around Houston.

For those looking to take a break from the crowds, charming nearby towns like Fredericksburg, famed for its wineries and rich German heritage, offer the perfect escape.

The Road to the Opener - Miami to Dallas

Alternatively, England fans can pick up their campervan from the [Miami depot](#) and kick off their 2026 World Football Championship journey by catching the team's pre-tournament friendlies, soaking up the anticipation and excitement ahead of the competition.
