7. **Palamós – Camping Palamós** (Costa Brava)

- **National Day of Spain – Across Spain** (12th October)
Spain’s national holiday features military parades, especially in Madrid, patriotic celebrations, cultural events and public ceremonies. A chance for travellers to see official traditional, flag raising and local festivities.
- **Andalucía Golf Masters – Sotogrande, Real Club Valderrama** (17th – 20th October)
For sports lovers, this prestigious golf tournament brings international field players to one of Spain’s iconic courses. A great option for combining sport, scenery and relaxation.
- **Regional Fair of Iberian Ham and Pig – Aracena, Huelva** (24th – 26th October)
A gastronomic fair dedicated to ham and Iberian pork. Expect tastings, local food stalls, cultural activities and a festival atmosphere rooted in rural Andalusian life.
- **SEMINCI, Valladolid International Film Festival – Valladolid** (24th October – 1st November)
One of Spain’s longest-running film festivals with auteur films, retrospectives and a strong independent cinema focus.
