It's also one of the best seasons for a road trip, with cooler temperatures and iconic sights from coast to coast.

Whether it's catching a prime-time NFL clash on the West Coast or soaking up the buzz of playoff baseball in the Northeast, roadsurfer campervans provide fans with the freedom to follow the action at their own pace. The vans can double up as a mobile base, ideal for a classic American tailgate, a lively-pregame gathering in the stadium car park complete with barbeques and music, unwinding post-match or linking multiple stadiums into one unforgettable road trip.

Each roadsurfer vehicle is equipped for sports fans on the move, featuring a built-in kitchenette with a gas stove, fridge and sink – perfect for chilling drinks, grilling burgers, or prepping snacks for a day at the games. With plenty of storage, comfortable sleeping areas, and an optional roof tent on some vehicles, fans can camp near stadiums or hit the road straight after the final whistle.

Los Angeles, California

From tailgates under the palms to baseball under the stars, LA is where sports meet Hollywood flair. From September, NFL (National Football League) fans can support the LA Rams at the SoFi Stadium,

whilst MLB (Major League Baseball) fans can cheer on the LA Dodgers at the Dodger Stadium in October. Travellers can explore LA with a hike up to the famous Hollywood Sign, visit the Santa Monica Pier, surf or sunbathe at Venice Beach, or explore street art in Downtown LA's Arts District. After a day of exploring, camp overnight at Malibu Creek State Park for nature and stargazing after the game.

San Francisco, California

Combine iconic city sights with all-American football and baseball – plus incredible camping just beyond the skyline. Visitors can catch a MLB game with the San Francisco Giants at Oracle Park or see the San Francisco 49ers play American football at Levi's Stadium. Fans can drive across the Golden Gate Bridge, visit Alcatraz, or explore the murals of The Mission District. To carry on the adventure, travellers can visit Muir Woods National Monument for a day trip and spend the night in Half Moon Bay or nearby Big Basin Redwoods State Park to stargaze in the forest.

Seattle, Washington

Seattle makes the perfect place for a road trip due to the incredible tailgate culture and some of the loudest fans in American football, surrounded by misty mountains and pine forests. NFL fans can watch the Seattle Seahawks at Lumen Field, and after a day of cheering, travellers can take a ferry to Bainbridge Island or explore Mt. Rainer National Park, followed by a camp along Lake Sammamish or Deception Pass State Park for coastal views.

Miami, Florida

NFL excitement paired with tropical nature detours and epic coastal drives, make this Florida route a dream for sports-loving travellers. From September to January, fans can catch the Miami Dolphins playing American football at Hard Rock Stadium. For baseball fans, the Miami Marlins play at Loan Depot Park from April to September. After the matchday buzz, travellers can hit the Overseas Highway for a stunning drive through Florida Keys, snorkel at John Pennekamp Coral Reef State Park, or kayak through the mangroves in Everglades National Park. For a dose of local culture, soak up the art deco charm of South Beach or sample Cuban flavours in Little Havana.

Las Vegas, Nevada

Only in Vegas could you watch American football under the glow of neon lights. From September to January, fans can catch the Las Vegas Raiders playing in the NFL at Allegiant Stadium. Baseball fans can also enjoy a game with the Las Vegas Aviators at the open-air Las Vegas Ballpark. Following the games, fans can head out of the city for a sunset hike in Red Rock Canyon, a scenic drive through the Valley of Fire, or a night of stargazing and swimming by Lake Mead.
